To my fellow Directors. thank you so much for your support and wisdom which has so effectively enabled us to guide our wonderful club.

CEO's Report.

I am pleased to report that Pittwater RSL Club limited has exceeded expectations and achieved several important milestones in the year ended December 2022, including

- Membership Growth of 46.296 in 2022 compared to a decrease of -19.256 in 2021.
- A Net Comprehensive Income for the 2022 year of \$69,619 was achieved compared to a loss of \$1,248,536 in 2021.
- Operational indicators have strengthened notably the Earnings before Interest Tax.
 Depreciation & Amortisation (EBITDA) percentage grew to 22.2% from 15.1% in 2021.
- During 2022 we intensified our community interaction and support and it was encouraging to note that our direct donations grew by 32.3%.
- The long term secured debt of the company was reduced by 50% during the course of 2022, and at the time of writing this report we have managed to eradicate it completely. This is encouraging as it maximises the potential financing options available to the company in the event that future developments are considered.

This has been accomplished through the careful application of targeted management processes and the alignment with the Boards strategic direction whilst maintaining and investing in both people and capital.

Our social media engagement, marketing content, and brand awareness have all increased considerably, proving that our strategies are driving positive results. The team has worked hard to deliver strong financial results. and I am pleased to report that we have achieved an EBITDA (Earnings Before Interest, Taxes, Depreciation and Amortization) of \$3,147,133.00 or 22,2% and is an incredible accomplishment under the circumstances. This achievement is a testament to the team's ability to manage our resources effectively and efficiently and allows us to confidently enter 2023 with a solid financial platform and a view to further investment. in the future.

Our focus for the year ahead is to continue to build on the successful strategies we have in place over the past few years. We plan to further invest in our marketing strategies, customer engagement processes and community. Furthermore, as a result of the ever changing hospitality and entertainment landscape. Pittwater's Board and Management will continue to

consider alternatives to diversify and strengthen our revenue streams and enhance the Club site for the benefit of the Members and the Community.

Overall, this has been a successful and productive year and we have benefitted from a united and progressive Board of Directors, led by the Clubs President Mr Leigh Arnold, who all voluntarily give generously of their time. I thank the Board for their support and guidance, without which, none of the year's achievements would have been possible.

I am fortunate to be at the helm. of a great team focussed on the improvement of our members and guest's experiences at the Club and would like to convey my personal thanks to each of them for their commitment. and unwavering hard work and dedication to ensure that Pittwater continues to lead and not follow other Clubs within its market areas. I am extremely proud of the financial and operating results that we have all achieved. The team has been truly amazing, and I am extremely grateful - thank you all.

And finally. I would also like to thank our members and guests for their ongoing loyalty and support, without whom our success would not have been possible. Here's to a successful 2023!
